# BASIC OBEDIENCE: WHAT TO EXPECT

The Basic Obedience Class is for all dogs from puppy to adult. The starting age for class is 16 weeks old. There is no upper age limit. If you are looking for a Puppy or Advanced Class, please speak to the instructor as those classes are formed only when enough dogs are signed up. Minimum class size is 3 dogs. The focus of Basic Obedience Class will be the following:

-  HEEL
-  SIT
-  DOWN
-  STAND
-  STAY
-  COME WHEN CALLED

## CLASS SPECIFICS:

-  LENGTH: 7 WEEKS
-  DAY: TBD

-  COST: \$175 + TAX (Class size is limited, therefore a non-refundable down payment of \$75 is required at least 1 week prior to the start of class to confirm your place. The rest of the payment is required on the day of the first class. *(Prices are subject to change without notice)*)
-  BRING A CURRENT COPY OF VACCINATION RECORDS

Please be sure you can commit to the entire 7 weeks as the benefit to your relationship with your dog is maximized. Due to the nature of the class, we cannot give refunds for missed classes. Once the first class is attended, it is assumed you will be completing the course. We understand things can happen and should you miss a class, please contact the instructor to find out what work needs to be done. Excessive absence cannot be accommodated and the course will have to be taken again and paid for in full.

ON YOUR FIRST DAY OF CLASS please arrive early to check in with the instructor. At that time, your instructor will recommend a collar and lease appropriate for training. These items can be purchased at The Pampered Pooch and Pals. A fanny pack or treat pouch are useful but not required. DO NOT BRING crunchy or chewy treats. Pick a SOFT TREAT that can be cut into small pieces and swallowed quickly by your dog. Zuke's or Bill Jac Treats are both excellent training rewards as well as hot dogs cut into small pieces.

One person should be selected from your family to be your dog's partner in training.
